## About Odyssey House NSW

At the heart of our work is a belief in the power of individuals to strengthen not only their lives but rebuild family bonds and reconstruct community connections.

#### How we support people

Odyssey offers comprehensive support, treatment and education through community and residential programs across Sydney and New South Wales.

- Medically supervised withdrawal unit.
- Live-in residential rehabilitation and support centres.
- A suite of family programs to support parents and children.
- Individual and group counselling, support and information.

#### Specialist support

- Support for people from culturally and linguistically diverse communities.
- Support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.
- Diversion programs and community development.
- Educational opportunities and job skills through Odyssey College.

Our holistic approach supports you to address not just your alcohol and drug issues, but all the challenges impacting your life.

#### **Residential Programs**

Live-in residential rehabilitation to support people in their recovery from alcohol and drug use. Supportive 24-hour staffed residential treatment. Medically assisted withdrawal unit.

#### **Community Programs**

Individual and group counselling, support, information and education for people concerned about their own or family or friends drug or alcohol use.

#### **Family Support**

Our Reconnecting Families suite of programs support parents and children through a range of supports and services. This includes home-like residential programs for parents with young children.

#### **Multicultural Programs**

Alcohol and other drug services delivered in 20 languages for people from culturally and linguistically diverse communities.

#### Mingu Yabun for First Nations People

Specialised alcohol and other drugs counselling and support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in both our community and residential programs.
